

Compensation based on Purchasing Power Parities (PPPs)

Compensation for participating companies is calculated using the Purchasing Power Parities (PPPs) applicable to the respective country. The calculation is based on countries that have concluded Government Procurement Agreements (GPAs) with Germany.

The compensation amount is adjusted according to the relative purchasing power of the country concerned. For countries with lower purchasing power, the compensation may be reduced according to the list below. For countries with higher purchasing power, the remuneration is capped at the applicable maximum amount.

Maximum remuneration amounts:

- Basic Path (Lot 1): up to €15,000
- Advanced Path (Lot 2): up to €30,000

The calculation is based on PPP indicators for the reference year 2024.
